

ARCTIC FOXES POST GAZETTE PAVILION FUNDRAISER

The Arctic Foxes will again be participating in the Post Gazette Pavilion fundraiser for the 2008 concert season. This is a fun and profitable fundraiser but keep in mind it is also hard work.

This fundraiser requires a large commitment from the organization as well as a large number of volunteer participants. As a participant in this fundraiser you will need to have an up to date **TIPS Certification**. **TIPS** classes are posted on the web site and it is your responsibility to attend a class in order to work at the concerts. You will need to carry your **TIPS Card** with you at each concert you work. Once received, **TIPS** certification is valid for three years.

We have **B-Lawn Beer Booth**, on the lawn that sells beer, Jack Daniel's cocktails as well as soda and snacks. This booth will require 2-4 people per show and must be staffed for every show. This booth is closed each evening at the discretion of the PGP, usually just prior to the end of the show. We have a **Jack Daniels Booth** that sells Jack Daniel's cocktails as well as some other items. This booth will require 2-4 people per show and must be staffed for every show. This booth is closed each evening at the discretion of the PGP, usually just prior to the end of the show. We also have available **C Main**, a large concession stand that sells beer, soda and a variety of foods. This booth will be open every show, for the entire show. **C Main** will require 15 to 25 people per show depending upon ticket sales.

A web site has been established with a schedule of the shows for you to view and bid upon. Bids will open in April. *(Please see rules and regulations)*

There is a form located on the web site to register to work the shows. Everyone must complete the registration form before bidding on a show.
